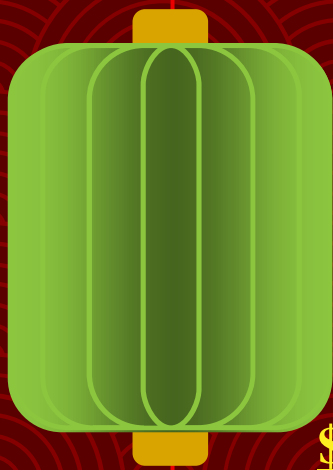


Moon Cakes

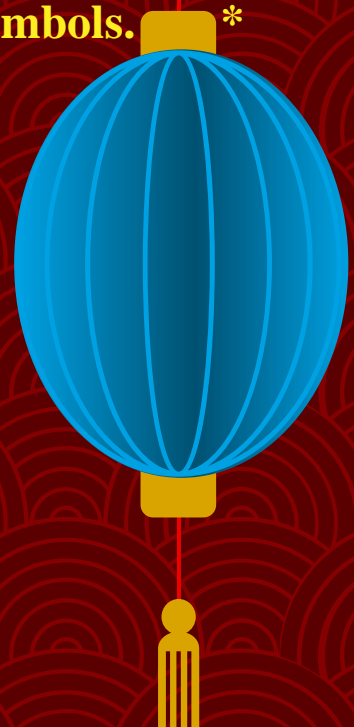
