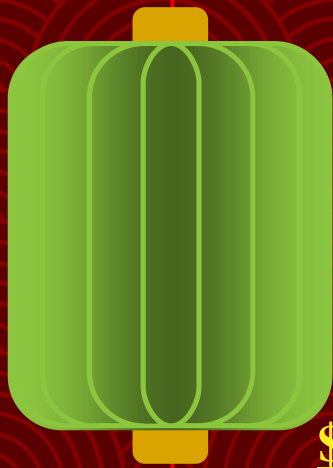


# Moon Cakes
